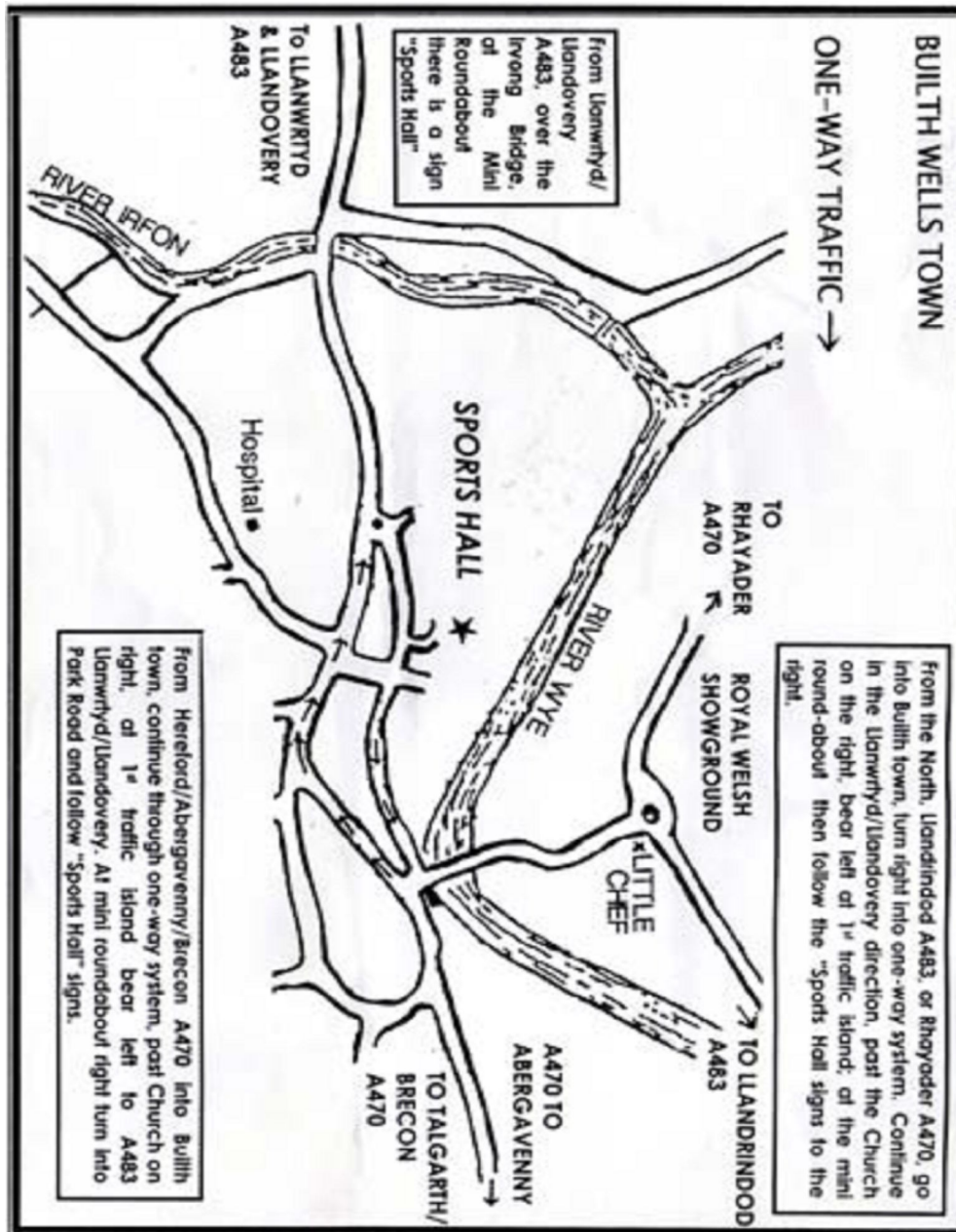

Compound Archers:	May shoot on separate Portsmouth faces, according to entry.
Dress:	All Archers are expected to comply with GNAS rules and regulations regarding dress
Entry Fees:	Please Note: No entries accepted unless fees are paid prior to the tournament.
Late Entries	Accepted subject to the availability of target space and then only following a 'phone call to the tournament Organiser prior to 7pm on the Wednesday prior to the Tournament Date. Late telephone bookings – Archers will be expected to pay entry fees if they do not turn up to shoot on the day – an account will be sent after the tournament if any archers fail to attend. No substitutions under any circumstances.
Target List/Results List:	2 Large SAE's please to Tournament Organiser or put email address on the entry form.
Registration:	All archers are requested to register upon arrival at the Hall.
GNAS Cards:	If the GNAS number is not stated on the entry form, cards MUST be presented at the time of registration. Proof of GNAS membership must be shown to the Tournament Organiser if requested.

Disclaimer:	SAMPAA are unable to accept any responsibility whatsoever for the loss of or damage to any archer or equipment during the Tournament Backstop netting will be erected. SAMPAA will not accept any responsibility for damage to any arrows missing the target boss, or any arrows passing through any boss or netting
Catering:	No catering facilities are available other than snacks/hot and cold drinks machines in the Sports Hall.
Awards	1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd Recurve, Longbow, Compound, Barebow/Traditional – Seniors & Juniors. Classification Medals also awarded. If classification is not included entrant will not be eligible for an award.
Medal Criteria:	All awards subject to entries in each class: 1-3 archers – 1 st only 4-6: 2 nd , 7or over: 3 rd awarded.
Scoring	Archers are responsible for ensuring their scores are correctly recorded WHILST AT THE TARGET and should confirm the total is correct and signed for. No alteration is to be made to the score sheet to the advantage of any archer after the arrows have been withdrawn from the target. The Judge must be called if an incorrect score is recorded on the sheet whilst scoring is in progress.
